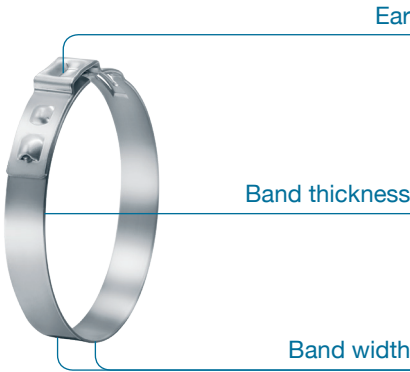

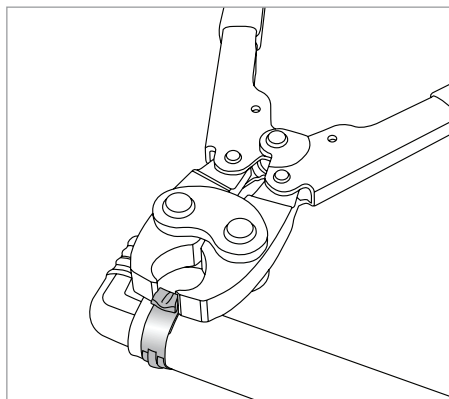
FOR CLAMP REMOVAL ONLY.

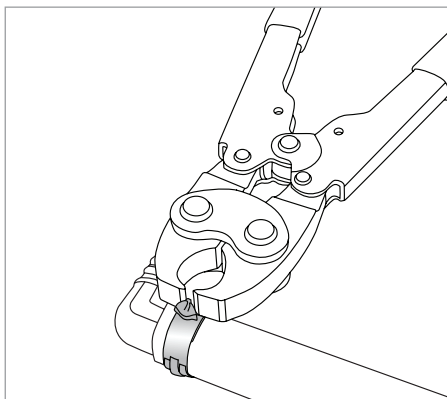

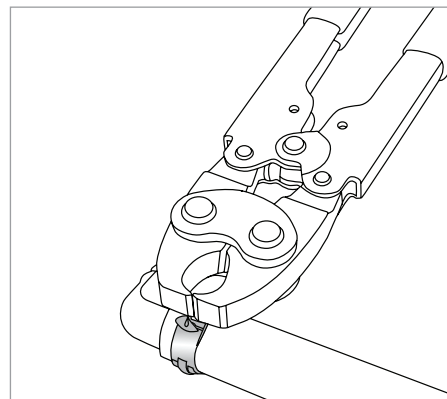
INSTRUCTION GUIDE



1. Place jaw tips on each side of clamp ear or single leg.



2. Squeeze handles.



3. Cut through the ear and remove the clamp carefully.

CAUTION

Laceration hazard and crush hazard at the pincer jaws!

Make sure the pincers are positioned correctly.

Make sure there is nothing but the clamp ear between the pincer jaws.

CAUTION

Risk of injury due to ejected metal splinters!

Wear safety glasses!
